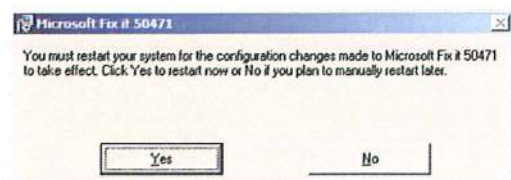
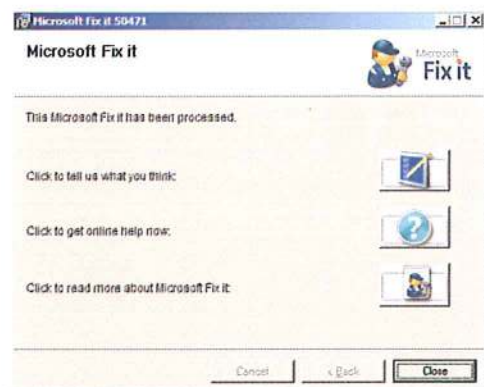
## Subject: How to disable the Autorun functionality in NavPC (Windows XP)

### Summary

Removable USB/thumb drives use the Autorun feature to load files when the drives are plugged into the USB port. Malware exploits the Autorun feature to spread from thumb drive to PC, so we need to disable the Autorun feature to prevent malware from spreading.

### Solution

1. On the NavPC, shutdown all software applications
2. Copy the file "Disable Autorun.zip" to C:\temp\
3. Open the zip and run the file "Disable autorun.msi" by double-clicking it
4. Click "I Agree" on the license form, then click Next
  
5. The update should take a few seconds.
6. Click "Close" when it's completed.
  
7. Remove any USB drive from the PC
8. Click "Yes" to restart the PC.
9. Test the auto-run is disabled by inserting a USB drive – no explorer dialog should appear
10. Please report the successful application of this update in the usual way
